This project will reconstruct sidewalks to City standards, and include the installation of streetlights, street parking, street trees and ADA compliant curb ramps. It will also involve demolition of the old Tuolumne Diverter Road. The improvements are part of the urban grid and pedestrian network within the Fulton Corridor Specific Plan area.

The Engineer's Estimate for this expenditure is \$611,255 The contract price is 56% above. (If the overage is greater than 10% provide an explanation below.)

The project received three bids, all three were above the Engineer's Estimate. The bid evaluation results highlighted that all bid amounts were within an acceptable range (7%), thereby validating the bid accuracy. There are several factors that contributed to the higher-than-expected bid prices, from cost increases for material and labor, along with long delays for material acquisition, and the relatively small size and location of the project. Given the current bid results and market conditions, staff recommends awarding the project.
