VISION ZERO ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2022, by Resolution No. 2022-183, the City Council authorized the submission of a grant application to the United States Department of Transportation Safe Streets for All program for the development and adoption of a Vision Zero Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2024, the City Council approved a professional consultant agreement with TDG Engineering, Inc., and affiliate of Toole Design Group, LLC., for the development of a Vision Zero Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2026, city staff presented the developed draft Vision Zero Action Plan to City Council.
