I family and I live in a new Granville Community at Copper & Chestnut. In the two years we have lived here we have noticed very little progress in setting up traffic lights, completing sidewalks for kids to SAFELY walk to Clovis North/Granite Ridge and general things that help to reduce excessive speeding along Copper Ave from Willow to Friant. We have had many close calls from drivers who do not stop during peak hours when school starts (8am-8:30 AM) and during the afternoon when school lets out (2:45 pm - 3:45pm). On the weekends we have to be extra careful as car speed down Copper and are not looking for pedestrians..In the late evenings we hear cars racing and doing burnouts at the end of Chestnut along the Copper River Golf Course Property

And now there's been a NEEDLESS fatality. I feel so sad for the families involved. My only surprise is that is hasn't happened sooner. Please turn ON ALL traffic lights that are installed on Copper Ave from Willow to Friant ASAP!
