PARCS is proposing to use the State Prop 68 Per Capita funding to install picnic shelters with picnic tables, bbqs and ADA pathways at the following park sites:

Logan Park (D2)

Cal/Tupman (D3)

Robinson (D4)

Sunnyside (D5)

Lafayette (D6)

Radio (D7) will be considered as an alternate site. If Radio Park improvements are resubmitted for the Prop 68 Statewide Park Development Program and not awarded funding, any remaining funds in Per Capita may be put toward picnic shelter improvements at Radio Park.

Final determinations will be based on costs estimated for amenities, and available funding.
