

RESOLUTION NO. ____

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, EXTENDING A POLICY AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO REDUCE AND/OR ELIMINATE SELECTED CITYWIDE IMPACT FEES FOR INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS THAT CREATE NEW JOBS, INCREASE ASSESSED PROPERTY VALUATION, AND PROMOTE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2014-18 the City adopted a policy to provide incentives to facilitate industrial development and revitalization within the City of Fresno (the "Policy"); and

WHEREAS, the City continues to value industrial development that creates permanent jobs, increases property taxes, and promotes additional business attraction, retention and expansion, which are the foundation of the financial well-being of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Policy has been effective in incentivizing industrial development; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to conduct a comprehensive review of its citywide impact fees, and expects the review will take place within the next year; and

WHEREAS, by its terms, Resolution No. 2014-18 is set to expire January 30, 2015, one year from the date of its adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Council deems it beneficial to extend Resolution No. 2014-18 until such time that Council takes action to repeal the Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. Resolution No. 2014-18 shall be extended until such time Council takes action to repeal the Policy.
