A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR A GRANT OF UP TO \$200,000 FROM THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO FUND DIGITAL LITERACY EDUCATION AND DIGITAL ACCESS AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THIS GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has announced the availability of funding through California Advanced Services Fund (CASF) Adoption Account; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) wishes to apply for and accept funding to provide digital literacy education and digital access to community members; and

WHEREAS, the City, if successful, will enter into a grant agreement with CPUC for the implementation of grant funded programming; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno must demonstrate dedicated and available local matching funds for a 15% project match (up to \$30,000).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. Council authorizes staff to apply for a grant of up to \$200,000 from the CPUC to fund Digital Literacy education and Digital Access for community residents.
- 2. Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to conduct negotiations, execute, submit and sign all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and other documents which may be
