A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO (CITY), CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF FOOD SERVICE EQUIPMENT OF A VALUE NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 FROM THE FRESNO-MADERA AGENCY ON AGING (FMAAA) TO BE USED FOR SENIOR HOT MEALS PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION (CITY-WIDE)

WHEREAS, Fresno Municipal Code (FMC) Section 7-105 requires that gifts presented to the City, or a City department or agency, that exceeds \$25,000 in the aggregate must be presented to the Council for acceptance or refusal; and

WHEREAS, FMAAA has offered to provide food service equipment to the Parks,
After School, Recreation and Community Services (PARCS) Department to carry out
Senior Hot Meals programming; and

WHEREAS, the PARCS Department is seeking authority to accept the equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. Council approves the acceptance of food service equipment of a combined value not to exceed \$50,000 from the Fresno Madera Area Agency on Aging (FMAAA) to the PARCS Department for the Senior Hot Meals Program at six community centers: Inspiration, Lafayette, Mary Ella Brown, Mosqueda, Pinedale, and Ted C. Wills; and
  - 2. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
