WHEREAS, On December 14th, 2019, the Fresno City College Men's Wrestling Team was declared to be the California Community College Athletic Association State Champions. The FCC Men's Wrestling Team made history with this year's win becoming the first ever school who has won four consecutive state championships; and

WHEREAS, Coach Paul Keysaw has led Fresno City teams to nine state titles and twelve overall in his 25 years coaching at the junior college level; and
