
On October 13, 2023, the City sent a copy of Substantial Amendment 2023-02 to an address given to the City by H.E.A.T. so the organization would have an opportunity to comment on the substantial amendment prior to the November 13, 2023, deadline; the group's address has been redacted from the image in Figure 1.

The information provided to H.E.A.T. includes a justification of the necessity to reprogram funds, and details the grant name, program year, activity from which funds are being reprogrammed, and amounts from each activity that are being reprogrammed. The Substantial Amendment also provides information on the funds proposed to be reprogrammed for the use of land acquisition for future affordable housing development as well as relocation assistance for businesses impacted by the development of affordable senior housing. No requests for additional information were received from H.E.A.T. members.

To make the public aware of the substantial amendment, the City published a public notice in the Fresno Bee, provided access to the document on the City's website, promoted the substantial amendment on the City's Facebook account, sent an email update to more than 500 residents and advocacy organizations, and sent a hard copy to H.E.A.T. via traditional mail; however, it did not hold any public meetings. These methods are consistent with the City's Citizen Participation Plan outlined in the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan.

Residents are able to comment on the substantial amendment at the November 16, 2023, City Council meeting.

The City of Fresno (City) is a federal entitlement community that receives annual allocations of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The City is required to prepare Annual Action Plans detailing the use of entitlement funds to meet its affordable housing and community development goals as outlined in its 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan.


