RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the 37th amendment to the Annual Appropriations Resolution (AAR) No. 2022-154 to appropriate \$2,383,200 from General Fund surplus to fund the Water Tower Improvements, the Warming Centers, and Senior Center projects.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

As part of the FY 2023 Midyear Budget, a reconciliation of actual and anticipated revenues and expenditures of the General Fund was completed. The results reflect an Annual Net Ending Balance higher than budgeted of \$2,383,200 (Table 1). The Administration, based on Council's input, also offered recommendations to Council on proposed uses of these funds as reflected on Table 2.

BACKGROUND

During the February 23, 2023, Council Meeting the Administration presented the FY 2023 Mid-Year Budget Review Workshop which anticipated that the General Funds estimated year end revenues would exceed anticipated expenses and net transfers. This overall amount is projected to be \$2,383,200 as reflected by Table 1 below.

Subsequently, the Council subcommittee recommended the following project funding allocation:

- 1) Warming Centers In December of 2022 Council updated the Resolution Regarding Emergency Expansion of the City's Warming Centers. As of the publication of the FY 2023 Mid-Year Budget Review Workshop it was estimated that the resources allocated to this project were approximately \$300,000, however, due to several extensions of the operation that ended on March 21, 2023 the total actual non-reimbursable costs total is \$505,200.
- 2) Water Tower On January 27, 2022 Council approved a three year lease agreement with Frida Café for the Historic Water Tower. As part of the Lease Agreement, the City is required to upgrade the electrical service. The revenue surplus will provide \$878,000 towards this project.
- 3) Senior Center The remaining balance of \$1 million will be allocated to the Citywide Senior Center.

ENVIRONMENTAL FINDINGS

By the definition provided in the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15378 this item does not qualify and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act Requirements.

LOCAL PREFERENCE

Local Preference does not apply to the projects included in this report as this is a funding item only. Local preference (if applicable) will be considered at the time of contract award.

FISCAL IMPACT

All projects will be funded by the additional General Fund surplus revenues.
