

CERTIFICATION OF SUFFICIENCY OF  
INITIATIVE PETITION PERTAINING TO PROPOSED  
FRESNO CLEAN AND SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD  
PARKS TAX ORDINANCE

I, Yvonne Spence, City Clerk of the City of Fresno, California, do hereby certify:

That on July 18, 2018, proponents submitted to my office a petition for an initiative pertaining to proposed Fresno clean and safe neighborhood parks tax ordinance.

That pursuant to Election Code Section 9215, it has been determined that the Fresno County Registrar's last official report of registration to the Secretary of State for the City of Fresno was 234,260 registered voters and that 10% of said registration would require 23,426 valid signatures to qualify the initiative petition.

That in accordance with Election Code 9210(b), it has been determined that said petition contained 35,359 signatures (prima facie count). Pursuant to Elections Code Section 9211, petition signatures were examined by the Fresno County Registrar as per Election Code Section 9115, and that Office has determined that 27,623 signatures of the total amount submitted are valid.

Therefore, the initiative petition for Fresno clean and safe neighborhoods parks tax initiative, submitted by the proponents is deemed to be sufficient.
