WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fresno adopted the 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan on May 26, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City conducted a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) process to identify qualified activities to meet the project objectives as outlined in the 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan for Fair Housing; and

WHEREAS, Staff reviewed the applications for eligibility and scored the applications according to the criteria described in the NOFA and thereafter prepared a recommendation in consultation with an ad hoc committee of the City Council of applications and corresponding funding levels for approval as set forth in Exhibit "A"; and
