RESOLUTION - Requesting the California Air Resources Board Delay
Hearings on Proposed Updates to the State Low Carbon Fuel Standard to
Assess Fiscal Impact on Taxpayers.

Council President Perea called this item to order at 11:35 A.M. and cited concerns that there had been little to no transparency regarding the actual economic impact of the state proposed low carbon fuel standard updates. The public had seen no clear cost impact analysis to determine how detrimental an increase taxpayers could expect. She noted any increase would disproportionately impact taxpayers in the Central Valley at a much greater rate given the high percentage of low and moderate income households.

Vice President Karbassi stated California was pushing hard to be responsible stewards but the solution should not make California's middle-class families pay for the irresponsibility of other nations. Increased fuel prices to combat greenhouse gases would be unfair and harmful to the local economy when the greenhouse gas emissions are primarily caused by industry in China.
