AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, REPEALING SECTION 10-812 OF THE FRESNO MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO CONDITIONS ON POLICE RESPONSE TO PUBLIC SAFETY ALARM SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) enacted the Public Safety Alarm System Ordinance within the Fresno Municipal Code to set forth regulations governing burglary, robbery, fire and medical alarm systems within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council added Section 10-812 to Chapter 10 of the Fresno Municipal Code to place conditions on the Police Department's response to alarm systems in an effort to reduce the amount of false alarms; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Police Department have determined that the conditions specified in Section 10-812 of the Fresno Municipal Code conflict with the roles and responsibilities of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to repeal Section 10-812 of the Fresno Municipal Code, to eliminate any inconsistencies with the Police Department's roles and responsibilities regarding responses to public alarm systems.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 10-812 of the Fresno Municipal Code is repealed.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective and in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first day after its final passage.
