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BACKGROUND OF PROJECT

In recent years the City of Fresno has experienced rapid growth causing an increase in the number of congestion problems throughout the City. Staff was able to secure Measure 'C' and Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funding for this project in order to help implement the required congestion mitigation measures.

The proposed improvements will relieve congestion and reduce delays by constructing additional eastbound and westbound travel lanes and upgrading the existing traffic signal facilities. Additionally, the project will make improvements on the south side of Herndon by adding landscaping and a multi-purpose trail with barrier fence as facilitated by previous undergrounding of a portion of Fresno Irrigation District's Canal no. 124.

DEPARTMENT CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION:

Award a contract in the amount of \$1,689,986.00 to Emmett's Excavation, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
