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A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, SUPPORTING CALIFORNIA ASSEMBLY BILL 69

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno is concerned about the impact of the fuels-underthe-cap regulation and the increased price of fuel for consumers; and

WHEREAS, any increase in the price of fuel will serve to hurt the most vulnerable members of our communities who must continue to commute and drive long distances for services like healthcare, and who are least able to diversify their transportation options; and

WHEREAS, California is still in the early stages of its economic recovery and a price increase on fuel will serve to weaken the economic recovery; and

WHEREAS, many Californians are still unemployed and looking for work and are at a disadvantage when it comes to paying for basic necessities like fuel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno was more economically impacted by the "Great Recession" than many other cities throughout the state, and high poverty and double digit unemployment still persist in the City; and

WHEREAS, professional estimates put the probable increase in the price of gas between \$0.16 and \$ 0.76 a gallon; and

WHEREAS, increases in fuel prices will disproportionately impact low-income Californians who will be hurt the most by such a price increase; and

WHEREAS, the majority of Californians are unaware that this price increase is coming; and

WHEREAS, Assemblyman Henry Perea (D-Fresno) has introduced state legislation, Assembly Bill 69, seeking a delay in this implementation until January 1, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The City of Fresno call upon the administration of Governor Jerry Brown, the California Air Resources Board, and the California State Assembly and Senate to delay the implementation of this portion of the cap-and-trade program so that Californians may have more time to prepare for the economic consequences.
