WHEREAS, in October 2022, Leefong joined the City’s Planning and Development Department as a Project Liaison, where he played an important role in facilitating development-related communication and helped align projects with municipal processes and expectations, supporting positive outcomes for business, neighborhoods, and stakeholders navigating the development systems; and

WHEREAS, in May 2025, Leefong joined Councilmember Brandon Vang’s office as Chief of Staff, overseeing daily operations, budget planning, policy priorities, constituent services, and coordination with City departments and community organizations; and

WHEREAS, Leefong contributed to several noteworthy initiatives including efforts related to the Responsible Neighborhood Market Act, the Eviction Protection Program, smoke-free housing protections, and improvements to the Veterans Affairs Hospital parking district; and

WHEREAS, a dedicated and steadfast public servant to the City of Fresno, Councilmember Vang, and District 5 constituents, Leefong Mouavangsou has earned the admiration and respect of those who had the good fortune to work with him.
