- 2. The California Council for the Blind is celebrating its 90th Anniversary. The event is scheduled at the Piccadilly Inn Airport this weekend.
- 3. She attended the Fresno County Transportation Authority board meeting. All in attendance were in favor of putting Measure C on the ballot for 2026.

5. DAC SECRETARY AND ADA COORDINATOR REPORT

ADA Coordinator Joe Hinojosa stated the Department of Transportation moved toward adoption of PROWAG. DOT was looking specifically on comments from the public regarding transportation loading areas. ADA Coordinator briefly explained various infrastructure possibilities. Joe Hinojosa responded to questions from the board members.

7. PRESENTATIONS

FAX ADA Transition Update by Kristopher Grey, Projects Administrator

Kristopher Grey, Projects Administrator gave an update on the FAX ADA Transition Plan Report. He reported out on the following projects:

- FAX is working towards full ADA compliance at all 1,500+ bus stops.
- City Council approved FAX's commitment of \$500,000 annually towards ADA improvements.
 - Currently scheduled to complete full transition by 2054.

Completion of Shaw - Cedar Bus Stop upgrades:

- 63 stops improved Route 38 and intersecting routes
- Sidewalk, curb, gutter, 5 in-road bus layover pads, new amenities
- Contractor: Clean Cut Landscape
- Cost: \$2,697,398.46

Completion of design for next two phases of bus stop improvements:

Phase A

- 19 bus stops Routes 9, 26, 32, 34, 38, 41
- Awarded to Harris Development Corp. dba HBC Enterprises for \$577,999.00
 - Sidewalk, curb, gutter, and some repositioning of amenities
 - Construction begins in November 2024

Kris reviewed with the board members future projects for 2025.

Phase C design completion - November/December 2024 Construction expected to begin by May/June 2025 Estimated cost \$633,000

Phase D design completion - February/March 2025

Construction expected to begin by August/September 2025 Estimated cost \$739,000

Award design for Phases E through H - Spring 2025

Kris responded to questions from the board members.

Approve 2025 Meeting Dates/Times for Transportation Subcommittee

ADA Coordinator Joe Hinojosa reviewed with the board members the proposed 2025 Disability Advisory Commission (DAC) meeting schedule. Calendar invites have been sent out for the DAC 2025 meetings.
