BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

The Herndon and Shaw Avenue Pedestrian Signalization Upgrade Project will remove and replace existing pedestrian signal heads at every traffic signal along Herndon Avenue, from Golden State Boulevard to Willow Avenue, and along West and East Shaw Avenue from West Avenue to Chestnut Avenue. The scope of the project is to remove the existing pedestrian signal heads at each intersection and replace with countdown pedestrian signal heads to provide pedestrians clear notice of when to

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proceed with crossing the intersection, as well as providing the remaining green-time in the pedestrian phase of the traffic signal operation.

DEPARTMENT CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION:

Award a contract in the amount of \$137,772.00 to Cen-Pac Engineering of Fresno, CA, as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
