A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT STATE GENERAL FUND GRANT FUNDS FOR RADIO BILINGUE TO PURCHASE PROPERTY, COMPLETE ENTITLEMENT AND PERMITTING PROCESSES, PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AND COMPLETE DESIGN WORK FOR A NEW 9,000 SQ. FT. HEADQUARTERS AND BROADCAST FACILITY AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO SIGN ALL NECESSARY IMPLEMENTING DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California approved a general fund grant for Radio Bilingue to purchase property, complete permitting processes, purchase equipment and complete design work for a new public radio headquarters and broadcast facility through the California Budget Act of 2023; and

WHEREAS, the California Natural Resources Agency was delegated with the responsibility for the administration of the grant project, setting up necessary procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California Natural Resources Agency require the City of Fresno to certify by resolution the approval of a Project Information Package before submission of said package to the State; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno will enter into an agreement with the State of California for the above project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to accept State General Fund grant funding allocations in the amount of \$2,000,000 for the above project(s); and

2. Certifies that said agency understands the assurances and certification in the Project Information Form; and
3. Certifies that said agency will have sufficient funds to complete the project or will secure the resources to do so; and
4. Certifies that said agency will comply with the provisions of Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code.
5. If applicable, certifies that the project will comply with any laws and regulation including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws, environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable licenses and permits will have been obtained.
6. Certifies that said agency has reviewed and understands the General Provisions contained in the sample Grant Agreement contained in the Procedural Guide; and
7. Appoints the City Manager as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to the Project Information Form, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project(s).
8. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
