The Engineer's Estimate/Budget Allocation for this expenditure is \$ 607,000.00. The contract price is 35.7% above the Engineer's Estimate/Budget Allocation. If the overage is greater than 10% or only one bid was received, give explanation:

This project seemed to generate interest from the Contracting community only within the few days prior to bid opening. This likely limited general contractors from obtaining competitive bids from the various trade disciplines resulting in higher than expected bids to the City. Staff will contact bidders following Council action to investigate further.

BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

FAX's existing bus entry on 'G' street is past its useful life and the gate motors are prone to failure. Moreover, the existing gate placement requires vehicles to stage on the street blocking traffic while waiting to enter the FAX facility. This project will provide needed modernization and security improvements. The bus entrance will be demolished and reconstructed with high-speed security gates, guard shack, security cameras and concrete drives.

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
