MASTER FEE SCHEDULE OVERVIEW

Parks, After School, Recreation & Community Services (PARCS) Department

MASTER FEE SCHEDULE FOR SERVICES

- The Master Fee Schedule (MFS) Resolution reports fees for services that are provided to our citizens.
- Citywide Fees for all departments.
- Fees that do not recover the full cost of providing the service, resulting in a subsidy that shifts funds away from the critical, high priority needs of job creation, public safety initiatives, utility services, and neighborhood programs.

CITY CODE OF ORDINANCE:

- CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1 GENERAL PROVISION, Section 1-107.
MASTER FEE RESOLUTION.

All fees, penalties, refunds, reimbursements and charges of any kind collected by the city shall be specified in the Master Fee Schedule designated in the Master Fee Resolution, as amended by the Council from time to time. Whenever applicable throughout the Code, reference shall be made to the Master Fee Resolution in lieu of any reference to specific fee amounts.

PARCS FEE EXAMPLES

- Neighborhood Centers, Parks, and Playground Facilities
- Downtown Mall Vendor Fees
- General Recreation Fees
- Memorial Auditorium Rental Rates
- Fees Maintained Under Contract Agreement

AMENDMENT OF MASTER FEE SCHEDULE

- Annual review
- Add New Fees for new operations or programs offered
- Remove Fees or language of modified operations or programs
- Update Fees to align recovery with the cost of operation

PRAC ROLE

- CITY CODE OF ORDINANCE: Chapter 7 – CITY FINANCES, REVENUE, AND TAXATION ARTICLE 15, Section 7-1509 (e5) Fiscal Oversight and Budget Accountability
- The Commission shall have primary authority on behalf of the City to review and make recommendations to the Mayor and City Council on fees related to parks, trails, and open space

PARCS AMENDMENT SCHEDULE

- PARCS independent of City annual process this year
- MFS Amendments in review November/December
- Amendments for PRAC recommendations December
- Final Recommendation End of January
- Amendments to Fresno City Council for approval
