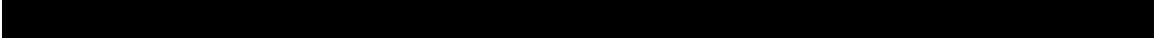

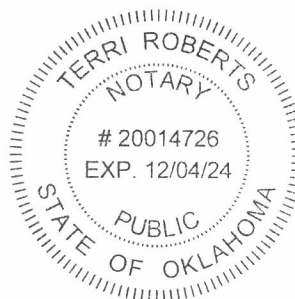

‘Hard Knocks’ features circus-like catches

Wide receiver CeeDee Lamb relaxed at training camp with a sweet berry peony-scented candle, running back Ezekiel Elliott was thankful for a supply of baby powder and a couple of Cowboys who hail from Pennsylvania faced off in a chess match.

The second episode of HBO’s “Hard Knocks: The Dallas Cowboys” docu-series aired last Tuesday, offering further insight into stars and fringe roster players, as well as coaching dynamic intricacies only known behind closed doors.

Sloppy practices? Head coach Mike McCarthy had publicly knocked his team for mental errors and missed assignments, but “Hard Knocks” displayed the attention to cadence as offensive coordinator Kellen Moore demanded all players stand, clapping on repeat, while rehearsing the snap. In an early scene, McCarthy emphasized to players during a meeting the importance of establishing a team personality rooted in physicality. Defensive line coach Aden Durde implored his position group: “We have to work on our mental toughness.”

Here are USA TODAY Sports’ top five highlights from Episode 2.

1. Circuslike catches demand center stage

Cowboys fans need not have tuned into “Hard Knocks” to discover highlight-reel catches from Lamb, the second-year star receiver. Those blanketed Cowboys Twitter from the first week of training camp. But the show did offer new jaw-dropping angles of Lamb’s one-handed heroics, while audio captured by the NFL Films crew shed further light into how teammates perceive Lamb’s consistent spectacles.

“That’s an easy guy to throw a go ball to,” quarterback Dak Prescott says. “See, he just walks underneath them.”

Micah Parsons, Dallas’ 2021 first-round pick, lauded the 2020 top selection as “nasty as (expletive).”

Owner Jerry Jones shared similar sentiments while video chatting with Hall of Fame receiver Michael Irvin during this week’s episode.

“His strength is noticeable, his work he’s done, he’s added pounds,” Jones said. “You can see just in the way he

snatches the ball. This guy wants to go out and make the plays. We’ve just got to use it. We’ve got to have it in his hands.”

2. Parsons’ relentless regard of the game

For the second straight episode, Parsons aimed to fight for more preseason snaps. His 14 chances (20% of defensive snaps) against Arizona pleased him no more than his previous 11 (19%). On the sideline, the rookie doth protest.

“You said a quarter and a half,” Parsons told senior defensive assistant George Edwards. “Coach, do you not remember what you told me?”

Parsons was credited with four tackles against the Cardinals in addition to a beyond-the-box-score instinctive stop that aided linebacker Keanu Neal’s forced fumble and recovery. Neal goaded Parsons on the bench, further lighting the fire: “I hope your ass is done so you can get (expletive) mad.”

Also featured: a scene in which Parsons, a games man who actually brought his own Connect Four board to Southern California training camp,

faces backup quarterback Ben DiNucci in a chess match. DiNucci ultimately won on account of what Parsons insisted was “one blunder.” The Pennsylvania boys exchanged jabs. “Against a Pittsburgh guy, I’ve never been nervous,” said Parsons, who grew up in Harrisburg. DiNucci’s winning gloat: “I guess the western part of PA is better than the eastern part of PA, huh?”

3. Defensive line coach flashes accent, acumen

Aden Durde rejoined the Cowboys coaching staff for a second stint this off-season. But the smooth accent with which he coaches bag drills immediately gives away Durde’s roots: He is British. As Durde coaches how best to attack with a strong outside arm, Jones offers a description reminiscent of the biblical scene when Isaac assesses whether he’s speaking with his son Jacob or progeny Esau.

“That defensive line coach, I look at him and he looks like he’s from Arkansas,” Jones says of Durde from the sideline of practice. “I listen to him, and he

sounds like Winston Churchill.” Durde’s accent generates laughter from defensive linemen, including end Tarell Basham, who commits to an impersonation during the episode. A reporter asks Durde whether he’s familiar with “Ted Lasso,” an American football coach tasked with coaching an English soccer team in the popular Apple TV show. Durde said he’s not seen the show. “But I’ve heard some people say that,” Durde adds. “I know who he is now.”

4. Highs, lows of bubble player’s journey

Cowboys pass rusher Azur Kamara missed the 2020 season with an injury designation. The 22-year-old Ivory Coast native fled the civil war with his family as a kid, finding refuge first in Guinea before reaching the United States and settling in Arizona. Kamara, who played college football at Kansas, is shown in the episode making contact with DiNucci during team drills – an inexcusable error, worthy of a firm Durde rebuke afterward. But during the pre-season game against the Cardinals, in which Kamara’s family attends, Kamara flashes with a would-be strip sack that was negated by a false start penalty. The play counts for naught, but the instinct drew props from teammates and coaches. Kamara’s mom smiles so interminably his sister tells her mother her “face is gonna hurt.”

5. Prescott makes progress

The Cowboys progress through this episode toward answering the biggest question of training camp: Prescott’s health. The quarterback slowly returning from a latissimus strain in his throwing shoulder resumes throwing in individual drills. Like in Episode 1, restrictions do not please him.

“Enjoyed the work man,” Prescott says after one session return, with a trace of bitterness. “I’m done; they pulled me. They pulled me.

“I’m on a pitch count. They called in the reliever.”

Prescott explains in detail how he instead embraces mental reps, envisioning his targets and adjustments while supervising team drills.

In the meantime, backups aim to capitalize on opportunities.

Backstory behind Kool-Aid McKinstry endorsement

Brenda Allen didn’t consider endorsement deals when she nicknamed her baby grandson, Ga’Quincy McKinstry, Kool-Aid. She thought about his smile – a big grin that reminded her of the Kool-Aid Man.

McKinstry has plenty to smile about these days.

Alabama’s highly touted freshman cornerback and the Kool-Aid drink announced an endorsement deal Wednesday, becoming the most obvious partnership to emerge since the NCAA began allowing college athletes to profit off their name, image and likeness on July 1.

In a full embrace of his nickname, McKinstry is listed as “Kool-Aid McKinstry” on Alabama’s roster.

After seeing McKinstry’s name recorded that way on the roster, the Kool-Aid brand thought: Oh yeah!

A partnership was born. McKinstry might be at the head of a trend.

Years from now, perhaps we’ll see all sorts of athletes on college rosters who are named after product brands in

hopes of landing an endorsement. “I think the NIL is going to make a lot of changes in the way people do a lot of things. I wouldn’t doubt that moms and dads are going to start naming their kids Heinz Ketchup and Kraft Macaroni,” joked Demarcus Thornton, McKinstry’s friend who served as his representative to help secure the deal. But there’s more to like about McKinstry than his name.

A five-star recruit, McKinstry was the nation’s No. 1-ranked cornerback in the 2021 recruiting class. He’s expected to receive ample playing time during his first season within an Alabama defense that will rank among the nation’s elite.

That means you can expect to hear Kool-Aid mentioned on a lot of television broadcasts this fall.

“He’s better than people think on the field, and he’s an even better person. He’s just a fantastic kid,” said Thornton, who played defensive back at West Alabama and met McKinstry a couple of years ago through a connection with NFL and former Alabama defensive back Dre Kirkpatrick.

And, importantly, Thornton said McKinstry drinks the product he’s endorsing, guzzling Kool-Aid Pink Lemonade “like it’s water.”

“That’s his favorite flavor,” Thornton said.

Even McKinstry’s given name, Ga’Quincy, lends itself to a slogan.

“Drink Kool-Aid. It’ll Ga’Quench your thirst,” said Thornton, a Gadsden, Alabama-based entrepreneur.

McKinstry appeared on “CBS This Morning” on Aug. 5 to discuss being

named the male athlete of the year by the USA TODAY High School Sports Awards after a standout senior season that culminated in Pinson Valley High School winning Alabama’s Class 6A championship.

During that nationally televised interview, McKinstry was asked about the possibility of an endorsement deal with Kool-Aid.

McKinstry already had signed a contract with the brand by that time, Thornton said, but the deal hadn’t been announced. McKinstry didn’t let it slip.

“Hopefully that’s something that can happen in the near future,” McKinstry told CBS.

McKinstry and the drink kept the partnership under wraps until Wednesday. To announce the deal, the Kool-Aid Man, the drink’s well-known mascot, swapped names with McKinstry on their Twitter and Instagram accounts for 24 hours.

McKinstry’s name topped the Kool-Aid brand’s account, while the Kool-Aid Man moniker shifted to McKinstry’s personal account.

The switcheroo reversed to its natural order on Thursday.
