A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING DESIGNATED PARADE ROUTES

WHEREAS, parades, marches, and other special events require substantial planning and preparation, both on the part of event-organizers, and on the part of the City staff; and

WHEREAS, pre-established routes with predetermined costs for crowd and traffic control would greatly help event-organizers to plan and budget for special events; and

WHEREAS, such pre-established routes would help to minimize the City staff time involved with processing applications for special event permits; and

WHEREAS, Fresno Municipal Code section 14-2414(f) authorizes the Council to establish designated parade routes for Expressive Activities, as defined in Fresno Municipal Code section 14-2403(f); and

WHEREAS, several rights-of-way within the City are either particularly suitable for hosting such special events, or have historically served as a venue for such events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- Pursuant to section 14-2403(f) of the Fresno Municipal Code, the following
 Parade Routes are established in the City of Fresno:
 - a. Downtown Parade Route, which shall begin at "P" Street and Tulare Avenue, and shall proceed along "P" Street to Fresno Street, then along

Fresno Street to "M" Street, then along "M" Street to Tulare Street, then along Tulare Street to 1800 Tulare Street.

- b. Fulton Street Parade Route, which shall proceed along Fulton
 Street between Tuolumne Street and Inyo Street.
- c. Olive Avenue Parade Route, which shall proceed along Olive Avenue between Palm Avenue and Maroa Avenue.
- 2. In accordance with subsection (g) of section 14-2403 of the Fresno Municipal Code, the City Manager is directed to specify the number of officers to be assigned to each route for crowd and traffic control. In addition, staff is directed to publish the following on the City's website: the aforementioned routes, the number of officers assigned to each route, and the fee schedule for police crowd and traffic control services.
- 3. This resolution shall be effective upon the final adoption of Bill No. _____, which amends the Parade and Other Special Events Ordinance.
