PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Environmental Assessment No. P18-03972 proposes an asphalt

overlay along Inyo Street from Van Ness Avenue to "P" Street, as well as installation of curb ramps, signal loop detectors, signage, and striping. The project is funded by the Federal Highway

Administration (FHA).

This project is exempt under Section 15301(c)/Class 1 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines as follows:

Under the Section 15301(c)/Class 1 exemption, the minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination, are exempt from CEQA requirements. Examples include but are not limited to existing facilities of publicly owned utilities and services; highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities. No significant effects would occur as a result of the proposed project. Therefore, the above described project complies with the conditions described in Section 15301/Class 1 of the CEQA Guidelines. None of the exceptions to Categorical Exemptions set forth in the CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2 apply to this project.
