The fees adjusted by this Resolution shall become effective on the effective date of Resolution No. 2025-____ [A Resolution of the Council of the City of Fresno Adopting a Vehicle Miles Traveled Nexus Study, Reduction Program, and Capital Improvement Plan as described in the Vehicle Miles Traveled Reduction Program and Nexus Study document dated September 2025, prepared pursuant to the requirements of California Public Resources Code section 21099, CEQA Guidelines sections 15064.3(b), 15064.7, and 15126.4, and the Mitigation Fee Act].
