A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FROM CALIFORNIA VOLUNTEERS YOUTH SERVICE CORPS PROGRAM GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,608,201 FOR THE ONE FRESNO YOUTH JOBS CORPS PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO SIGN ALL NECESSARY IMPLEMENTING DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the One Fresno Youth Jobs Corps Program was launched in Spring of 2022 with funding awarded by California Volunteers and the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City was notified on February 27, 2026, that California Volunteers planned to award the City of Fresno \$2,608,201 to continue providing the One Fresno Youth Jobs Corps Program to the community.

WHEREAS, the City must enter into an agreement with the Governor's Office of Service and Community Engagement (GO-Serve) to participate in the program and receive the funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to accept grant funds and sign all necessary implementing documents from California Volunteers Youth Service Corps Program Grant for the Youth Jobs Corps program for fiscal year 2027.
2. This resolution shall be effective upon final approval.
