A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FRESNO GENERAL PLAN AND THE ROOSEVELT COMMUNITY PLAN (PLAN AMENDMENT APPLICATION NO. A-16-014)

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2014, by Resolution No. 2014-226, the City Council adopted the Fresno General Plan which correspondingly adopted the Edison Community Plan, and the Fresno-Chandler Downtown Airport Master Plan and, by Resolution No. 2014-225, certified Master Environmental Impact Report SCH No. 2012111015 ("MEIR") which evaluated the potentially significant adverse environmental impacts of urban development within the City of Fresno's designated urban boundary line and sphere of influence; and

WHEREAS, Citadel Development Group, Inc., on behalf of High and Mighty Farms, Inc., has filed an application to amend the Fresno General Plan and the Roosevelt Community Plan to change the planned land use designations for the subject property from Medium-Low Density Residential (±22 acres), Medium Density Residential (±35 acres), Urban Neighborhood Residential (±15 acres), and Open Space/Neighborhood Park with a dual designation of Urban Neighborhood Residential (±6 acres) to Medium Density Residential (±63 acres), Residential Multi-Family Urban Neighborhood (±5 acres), Community Commercial (±7 acres) and Open Space/Neighborhood Park with a dual designation of Medium Density Residential (±3 acres); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno, based upon the testimony and information presented at the hearing and upon review and consideration of the environmental documentation provided, as follows:

1. The Council finds in accordance with its own independent judgment that with all applicable project specific mitigation measures imposed, there is no substantial evidence in the record that Plan Amendment Application No. A-16-014 may have additional significant effects on the environment that were not identified in the Fresno General Plan Master Environmental Impact Report SCH No. 2012111015 ("MEIR"); and, that all applicable mitigation measures of the MEIR have been applied to the project, together with project specific mitigation measures necessary to assure that the project will not cause significant adverse cumulative impacts, growth inducing impacts, and irreversible significant effects beyond those identified by the MEIR as provided by California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15178(a). Therefore, it has been determined based upon the evidence in the record that the project will not have a significant impact on the environment and that the filing of a mitigated negative declaration is appropriate in accordance with the provisions of CEQA Section 21157.5(a)(2) and CEQA Guidelines Section 15178(b)(1) and (2). Accordingly, the Council adopts the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for Environmental Assessment No. A-16-014/R-16-013/T-6165 dated October 21, 2016.

2. The Council finds the adoption of the proposed plan amendment as recommended by the Planning Commission is in the best interest of the City of Fresno.

3. The Council of the City of Fresno hereby adopts Plan Amendment Application No. A-16-014 amending the Fresno General Plan and the Roosevelt Community Plan to change the planned land use designations for the subject property
