WHEREAS, Councilmember Luis Chavez has served in the office of Councilmember for District Five; and

- 2. A vacancy is declared in the office of Councilmember for District Five effective January 7, 2025.

- 3. The Council hereby calls a special election to fill the vacancy for the remaining term in the office of Councilmember for District Five on March 18, 2025, or as soon as can be held thereafter. The City requests the County of Fresno perform necessary tasks to complete the special election. The City intends to pay the County for the election services it performs.
- 4. If no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast in the special election, the Council requests a second special election to be held at the soonest possible date in compliance with the Charter.
- 5. Pursuant to the process set forth in Charter Sections 2-1104 through 2-1106, candidates may submit a filing fee waiver petition. The City requests the County Clerk provide the fee waiver petition set forth in Charter 2-1104 and tabulate valid signatures at the rate of the filing fee for Councilmembers (\$300) divided by the number of signatures required for a fee waiver (250), or \$1.20 each valid signature.
 - 6. This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
