Cycle Two Update

- Staff have begun meeting one-on-one with grantees who received \$0 to enable contracting.
- Groups that received 90% up front have been contacted with information on next steps. The City is asking for final reports and expense reports to enable contracting.
- Interviews and hiring efforts have continued to provide support.
- Received feedback regarding sharepoint access and requests to use submittable due to familiarity. Working proactively to explore procurement.

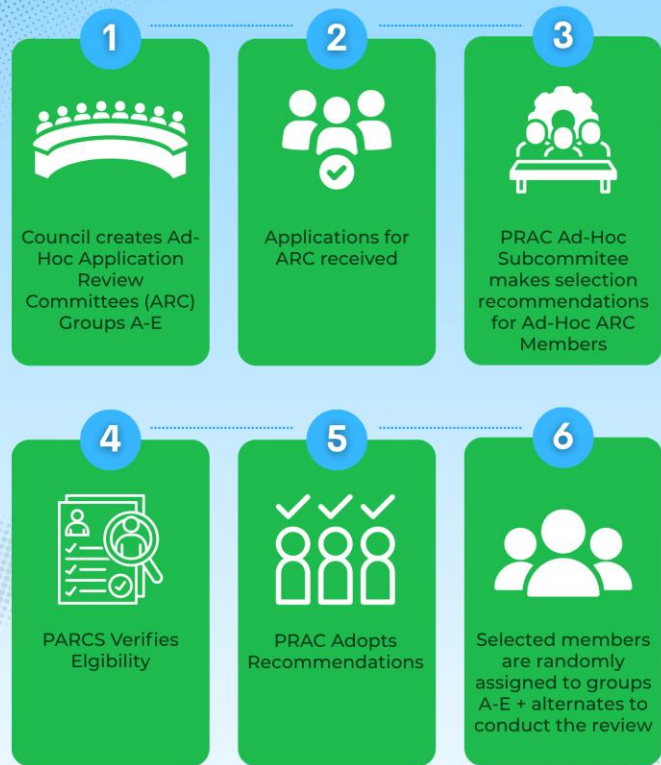

EAAC Cycle Three Updates

- On June 4, 2026 the Fresno City Council established an ad-hoc committee (ID-816) via adoption of a resolution.
- The ad-hoc committee is called the "PRAC Guidelines Ad Hoc Committee" established for the purpose of reviewing draft grant guidelines for the PRAC and provide feedback and recommendations to the full Council at its regular June 18, 2026 meeting."
- Feedback was provided and will be reflected in the draft published as part of the June 18, 2026 council agenda.



Next 30 Days

- Continue to meet with Cycle 2 Grantees and move forward with contracting/funding.
- Continue interviews/onboarding for staff.
- Launch the notice of funding opportunity (NOFO) for general operating support and project support grant solicitations on **June 30, 2026**.
- Finalize dates and deadlines.
- Update the City website with Cycle 3 information.
- Develop related documents; application for ARC, conflict of interest questions, etc.
