The RWRF operates 13 mesophilic anaerobic digesters. The digesters range in size from 860,000 to 1,870,000 gallons. The digesters are used in the treatment of the solids generated at the RWRF to eliminate pathogens and volatile organic compounds. Over the period of approximately seven years, these digesters accumulate debris associated with the treatment process (i.e. solids consisting of sludge, sand, plastics, hair, etc.).

Following the cleaning of Digester 8, inspection discovered failing coating peeling off the walls, visible gaps in the skirt seal around the digester, and stains on the roof where gasses have been escaping through failing welds. This Project includes the removal and
