<u>BACKGROUND OF PROJECT</u> (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

This Active Transportation Plan grant-funded project was conceived to address safety concerns for pedestrians including the students, parents, and staff from Robinson Elementary School, as well as residents of the apartments fronting Fresno Street who cross at Browning using the existing unsignalized painted crosswalk. The design phase of the project was initiated in the spring of 2020, shortly after the California Transportation Commission (CTC) funding for the project to begin. The preliminary engineering design and project management took approximately three years and was completed by City of Fresno staff.

The scope of the project at Fresno and Browning includes the installation of traffic signal to control vehicular and pedestrian movements, upgrade pedestrian facilities to meet current accessibility requirements, place green paint along the bikeways to make conflict areas more visible, placement of high-visibility crosswalk markings and improved street lighting. These improvements will create a positive impact for all roadway users by improving the overall safety of this intersection. The right-of-acquisitions necessary to accommodate construction has been fully obtained. Public Woks staff performed all survey and engineering tasks and prepared the construction documents for the project.
