A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF \$172,000.00 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION BOARD AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF GRANT RELATED DOCUMENTS FOR THE HABITAT RESTORATION AND REVEGETATION PLAN IN SUPPORT OF THE RIVER WEST EATON TRAIL EXTENSION PROJECT

WHEREAS, funds were made available to the Wildlife Conservation Board (WCB) for the enhancement or restoration of fish and wildlife habitat and for the development of public access facilities for hunting, fishing, or other wildlife-oriented recreational uses; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works submitted a grant application to the WCB seeking funding for the restoration planting and associated activities per the Habitat Restoration and Revegetation Plan (HRRP) prepared in support of the San Joaquin River Conservancy's River West Fresno, Eaton Trail Extension Project (Trail Extension Project); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno intends to develop plans, specifications, and estimates for the HRRP; and

WHEREAS, the Trail Extension Project will extend the existing Lewis S. Eaton Trail starting at the Perrin Avenue alignment near Highway 41 and ending at Spano Park with the goal of providing an enhanced river experience to the public by constructing improvements that will allow greater and easier public access to the 500 acres of open space along the south side of the San Joaquin River; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works was informed that the grant selection
