The properties along Daleville Avenue would then connect to the proposed sewer main and the existing septic tanks would be properly abandoned.

The Project is exempt under Section 15301 - Existing Facilities. Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. The Project involves septic-to-sewer consolidations accomplished through a minor extension of a sewer main along Daleville Avenue, an existing roadway, the minor alterations to existing properties to connect their sewage system to the City system, and the abandonment of the existing septic tanks. These minor alterations represent a negligible expansion in use of the impacted facilities. Furthermore, none of the exceptions to the exemption apply.
