A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE "CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC ACCESSIBILITY ACT"

WHEREAS, the Council adopted the City Council Public Accessibility Act (Act) in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic, via Resolution No. 2021-254 to allow the public to continue remote participation in Council meetings and to provide for multi-lingual translation for broadcasts of the same; and

WHEREAS, since the Act, state legislation no longer requires remote participation by the public, except when Councilmembers are participating remotely; and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to revise the Act to encourage in-person public participation in Council meetings, with the intent to continue video streaming of meetings, including closed captioning and translation into Spanish, Hmong, and Punjabi.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. Video streaming of meetings shall include closed captioning, as well as translation into Spanish, Hmong, and Punjabi.
- 2. This Resolution shall be administered by the City Clerk's Office. The City Manager shall identify sufficient funding and take all other actions necessary to implement this Resolution.
- 3. This Resolution shall be administered in compliance with the Brown Act. If any portion of this Resolution shall be held invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the rest of the Resolution.
