BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

The Blackstone and Fedora Avenues traffic signal installation will assist pedestrian's wishing to cross Blackstone. It is currently unmonitored and pedestrians cross Blackstone to the east to access public transportation and the shopping center. To the west is an existing elementary school, apartment complex, and residential neighborhood drawing pedestrians from the bus system. The installation of the signal will dedicate a traffic light to stop vehicles and allow pedestrians to cross Blackstone with their own dedicated pedestrian phase. This will alleviate and reduce the current pedestrian conflicts at the intersection.
