- WHEREAS, throughout its history, LifeBridge has demonstrated compassion and resilience in times of crisis, responding to economic downturns, natural disasters, and public health emergencies with practical support, hope, and faith in action; and
- WHEREAS, as it celebrates its 20th anniversary in 2025, LifeBridge Community Church is recognized not only for its faithful service and citywide impact, but for its lasting role as a trusted partner and essential part of Fresno's social and spiritual fabric.
