

FRESNO CITY PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 13320

The Fresno City Planning Commission, at its regular meeting on March 18, 2015, adopted the following resolution relating to Rezone Application No. R-13-010.

WHEREAS, Rezone Application No. R-13-010 has been filed with the City of Fresno to rezone the property as described below:

REQUESTED ZONING: M-3/UGM (Heavy Industrial/Urban Growth Management)

EXISTING ZONING: AL-20 (Limited 20-Acre Agricultural [Fresno County])

APPLICANT: Elias Saliba of Aesthetics Designs, on behalf of Gurudwara Nanak

Sar, a California Nonprofit Religious Corporation

LOCATION: 3015 South Cherry Avenue; Located on the southwest corner of

South Cherry and East North Avenues in the City and County of

Fresno, California

WHEREAS, the above-named applicant is requesting a zoning change on the above property in order to rezone the property consistent with the Edison Community Plan and the City of Fresno Fresno General Plan; and,

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2013, the District 3 Plan Implementation Committee reviewed the rezone application and recommended approval; and,

WHEREAS, the Fresno City Planning Commission on March 18, 2015, conducted a public hearing to review the proposed rezone, received public testimony and considered the Development and Resource Management Department's report recommending approval of the proposed rezone; and,

WHEREAS, at the hearing three people spoke in opposition to the proposed rezone application; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno City Planning Commission hereby finds and determines that there is no substantial evidence in the record to indicate that the rezone application may have a significant effect on the environment as identified by, and evaluated within, the Finding of Conformity prepared for Environmental Assessment No. ANX-13-001/R-13-010/C-13-088 dated March 6, 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fresno City Planning Commission hereby recommends

to the City Council that the requested M-3/UGM (Heavy Industrial/Urban Growth Management) zone district be approved.
