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Department Recommendation

Background (Explain the need for the procurement below):

The McKinley and Blythe Streets Project will deliver significant improvements to this intersection and the surrounding corridors, enhancing safety for pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists who rely on these facilities every day. The project scope includes the partial reconstruction of approximately 1,700 feet of Blythe Avenue and 1,000 feet of McKinley Avenue; construction of new curb, gutter, and sidewalk along portions of both streets, installation of bicycle facilities, and construction of a new traffic signal, including ADA-compliant ramps and crosswalks, at the intersection. The project is funded by the federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) and includes supplemental funding from the SB1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account. The County of Fresno is also contributing a Pro-rata share of the project costs.


