WHEREAS, Ronny Jungk has dedicated 38 years as a proud member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), beginning his career in 1987 as an apprentice and excelling by passing the California Electrical Certification Exam in the top 5% statewide; and

WHEREAS, Ronny pursued his education at Fresno City College before embarking on a distinguished career that combined technical expertise, leadership, and a lifelong commitment to creating opportunities for others in the electrical trades; and

WHEREAS, in 2002, Ronny was brought onto the staff of IBEW Local 100 as an Organizer, where for 14 years he worked tirelessly to help Fresno and County residents obtain apprenticeships and long-term careers, providing pathways to success for countless families; and

WHEREAS, in 2016, Ronny was elected Business Manager/Financial Secretary of IBEW Local 100, where he partnered with the Mayor and Fresno City Council on multiple Project Labor Agreements that ensured city residents had access to apprenticeship opportunities. Under his leadership, Local 100 membership grew from 700 to over 1,400 in just nine years; and

WHEREAS, Ronny’s commitment to labor and community extended far beyond Local 100, serving 23 years in the Local 100 office, including 12 years as Treasurer, 21 years with the Fresno, Madera, Kings, and Tulare Building Trades Council, 20 years on the Tulare Workforce Investment Board, and 14 years on the Kings Workforce Investment Board; and

WHEREAS, through his leadership and service, Ronny Jungk leaves behind a lasting legacy of strengthening the labor movement, expanding apprenticeship opportunities, and improving the quality of life for working families throughout Fresno and the Central Valley;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that we, Mayor Jerry Dyer and the Fresno City Council, do hereby honor and commend **Ronny Jungk** for his 38 years of dedicated service to the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, his steadfast leadership, and his unwavering commitment to opportunity and progress for the residents of Fresno.
