A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING THE J.B.
INDERRIEDEN COMPANY BUILDING LOCATED AT 2721
VENTURA STREET, FRESNO, CALIFORNIA TO THE
LOCAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC RESOURCES

WHEREAS, the J.B. Inderrieden Company Building was constructed in 1925 as a
raising packing plant for a Chicago-based cannery and packing company;

WHEREAS, the two-story reinforced concrete warehouse is one of several
commercial buildings located adjacent to the Santa Fe Rail Corridor in Fresno's
proposed Warehouse Row Historic District;

WHEREAS, the building was designed by James A. McCullough who was an
architect, engineer and builder;

WHEREAS, the building retains integrity to its period of significance with a
character-defining stepped parapet and art deco articulations on the street elevations
near to the cornice;

WHEREAS, the Inderrieden Building was previously evaluated in the 1994
Ratkovich Plan Survey and found eligible for listing for both its architectural and
economic significance;

WHEREAS, the property owners, Bitwise Land Company LLC, support the
designation of the building to Fresno's Local Official Register of Historic Resources;

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno Historic Preservation Commission, at a duly noticed public hearing held on November 14, 2016, heard testimony on the subject property;

WHEREAS, based on that testimony, and the presentation of facts relating to the criteria for official designation, as set forth in the Fresno Municipal Code, Chapter 12, Article 16, made the following findings;

That the J.B. Inderrieden Company Building meets the criteria set out in Article 16, Chapter 12, Section 12-1607 (a) of the Fresno Municipal Code; and is eligible for listing on Fresno's Local Register of Historic Resources; and be recommended to the Fresno City Council for adoption as a Local Resource; and whereas in accordance with Fresno Municipal Code, Article 16 Section 12-1601 et seq. this hearing has been duly noticed for Council action upon the designation recommended by the Commission; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2017, Council held a hearing where it considered the recommendation of the Historic Preservation Commission, and considered substantial evidence, including but not limited to, staff presentation, a report prepared by staff addressing the property's eligibility to the Local Register, a Primary Record ("PR") and a Building, Structure and Object Record ("BSOR") prepared by the City's Historic Preservation Specialist (as defined in FMC § 12-1604(b)) finding that the property met the Historic Resource eligibility requirements for criteria i and iii to subdivision 12-1607(a)(1).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. Council finds that the above recitals are true and correct.

2. Council finds that the J.B. Inderrieden Company Building is eligible for listing under criteria i and iii of Fresno Municipal Code, subdivision 12-1607(a)(1) based upon the evidence presented to Council in the staff presentation, staff report, the PR and the BSOR.

3. Council designates the J.B. Inderrieden Company Building a Historic Resource to the Local Register of Historic Resources.
