A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO ADOPTING THE 544th AMENDMENT TO THE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE RESOLUTION NO. 80-420 TO ADJUST THE CONDITIONS OF SERVICE WORK RELATED TO WATER CONSERVATION FINES LANGUAGE TO REFLECT AN UPPER LIMIT RATHER THAN A SINGLE FINE AMOUNT
