

RESOLUTION NO. 80-368

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO DESIGNATING THE HARDY'S THEATRE, LOCATED AT 944 VAN NESS, TO THE LOCAL OFFICIAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC RESOURCES

WHEREAS, at a noticed public hearing on May 22, 1980, the Historic Preservation Commission heard testimony on the subject property and recommends its designation to the Local Official Register; and

WHEREAS, at a noticed public hearing on June 17, 1980, the Council considered the recommendations of staff, the Historic Preservation Commission and all interested parties; and

WHEREAS, Hardy's Theatre, located at 944 Van Ness, was built in 1917; and

WHEREAS, the structure was the third largest theatre in the State at the time of its construction, and is the oldest theatre in the City; and

WHEREAS, the structure has remained basically unaltered and in good condition since initially constructed; and

WHEREAS, the structure is associated with many important events which have made a meaningful contribution to the community; and

WHEREAS, the structure materially benefits the historic character of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the structure is listed on the Fresno County Inventory of Historic Sites; and

WHEREAS, based upon the presentation of facts relating to the criteria for official designation, the structure has been evaluated and determined to have historic architectural significance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Fresno designates the Hardy's Theatre to the Local Official Register as set forth in Article 4 of Chapter 13 of the Fresno Municipal Code relating to the Preservation of Historic Structures.
