WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fresno, California, desires to submit a PIP grant application package (Application) on behalf of the City of Fresno (Applicant), an Eligible Applicant, on the forms provided by the Department, for approval of grant funding for eligible activities toward planning and implementation activities related to housing and community development as a result of meeting eligibility criteria including, but not limited to, Prohousing Designation.

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and submit an Application on behalf of the City of Fresno as Applicant to the Department in response to the NOFA, and to apply for the PIP grant funds in a total amount not to exceed \$1,400,000.

- 2. If the Application for the PIP grant is approved by the Department, the City Manager of the City of Fresno, or designee, is authorized and directed to enter into, execute, and deliver on behalf of the Applicant, a State of California Agreement (Standard Agreement) in a total amount not to exceed \$1,400,000, and any subsequent amendments or modifications thereto, as well as any other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to evidence, secure, and accept the PIP grant award.
- 3. The Applicant shall be subject to the terms and conditions as specified in the Guidelines and the Standard Agreement provided by the Department after approval. The Application and all accompanying documents are incorporated in full as part of the Standard Agreement. Any and all activities funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the Application will be enforceable through the fully executed Standard Agreement. Pursuant to the Guidelines and in conjunction with the terms of the Standard Agreement, the Applicant hereby agrees to use the funds for eligible uses and allowable expenditures in the manner presented and specifically identified in the approved Application.
