BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

This First overlay project, from Herndon Avenue to Alluvial Avenue, was initiated in FY17 when the City was awarded a federal grant from the Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP). The grant funds were obligated and the project was budgeted in the adopted FY18 Capital Budget by City Council. The design commenced following Council approval; preliminary engineering design and project management took approximately two and a half years.

The scope of the project includes a complete roadway grind and overlay throughout the limits of work, the reconstruction of several accessible ramps, damaged traffic detector loops, pedestrian push button relocations, pavement striping, and the addition of Green bike lanes at conflicting drive approaches. No changes to the existing traffic patterns are within the project scope. Rights-of-way were needed and were properly obtained in order to perform construction. Public Works Department staff prepared general construction documents for the project.
