Staff recognizes these facilities have suffered from deferred maintenance due to economic constraints. Update of this major transfer hub will provide a safer, more welcoming, attractive, and convenient environment for the large population of FAX customers using these facilities. This project will contribute to the overall efforts by FAX to improve service.
