A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO ADOPT AN AMENDMENT TO  
THE URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Urban Water Management Planning Act, codified at California Water Code Sections 10610, *et seq.*, requires every urban water supplier to prepare and adopt an Urban Water Management Plan and update said plan at least once every five years; and

WHEREAS, the City adopted its current Urban Water Management Plan (“UWMP”) on November 29, 2012; and

WHEREAS, a UWMP is to generally describe (1) the existing and projected water supply and demand; (2) water conservation measures, including a schedule for implementation and means for evaluating effectiveness; and (3) water supply reliability and water shortage contingency measures over a 20-year planning horizon; and

WHEREAS, the primary goals of the City of Fresno’s UWMP are to identify a long-term water supply, implement Demand Management Measures, and balance the City’s groundwater water usage (eliminate overdraft) by 2025, which will involve a customer-wide reduction of water usage by 20%; and City water customers as of 2014 use approximately 240 gallons of water per person per day, which is six years ahead of the original target date of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the City’s total water consumption is by the single-family residential customer class, and 96 percent of outdoor watering for single-family residential customers occurs between March 2 and November 30 of each year; and

WHEREAS, in tandem with promoting water-wise conservation and addressing current drought conditions, the City of Fresno recognizes that plants and vegetation improve quality of life and the environment, and require water to survive; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno wishes to amend Chapter 9 of the UWMP, the City's "Water Shortage Contingency Plan," to permit one day of watering per week between December 1 and March 1 under Stage 2 water conservation measures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. Table 9-3 of the City's Water Shortage Contingency Plan shall be amended to allow outdoor watering one day per week during the winter season (December 1 to March 1) under Stage 2 water conservation measures, permitting watering on Saturdays for odd-numbered addresses (1,3,5,7,9) and on Sundays for even-numbered addresses (0, 2,4,6,8), between the hours of 9:00 P.M to 9:00 A.M.

2. Summer outdoor watering shall remain at two days per week under Stage 2 water conservation measures.
