Rates shall be either: 1) The Basic Rates; 2) 10 percent to gross receipts; or 3) square footage rate, whichever is greater. Overtime shall be: 1) the rate identified as overtime; or 2) applicable rate set forth in Basic or Special Rates for the whole of shortest period in which overtime occurs.
