WHEREAS, since its founding on May 21, 1881, as the United States National Lawn Tennis Association, the United States Tennis Association (USTA) has served as a national steward of the sport, guiding the advancement and accessibility of tennis across the nation; and

WHEREAS, today, tennis stands as a lifelong sport, engaging more than 25 million participants nationwide while promoting physical vitality, discipline, and a strong sense of community among individuals of all ages and backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the Roeding Park Tennis Club, a non-profit public benefit organization, established in 1931, has long served as a pillar of the Fresno community by providing accessible programming, structured instruction, and opportunities for both recreational and competitive play; and

WHEREAS, supported by a dedicated network of more than 100 volunteers, in collaboration with the City of Fresno Parks Department, the Roeding Park Tennis Club continues to deliver inclusive programming for all ages and skill levels, while community-driven improvements to Roeding Park, including resurfaced courts and new amenities, have revitalized local engagement in the sport and supported the health and wellness of residents; and

WHEREAS, the USTA recognizes the month of May as National Tennis Month, a nationwide initiative that celebrates the benefits of tennis and encourages participation through local programs, public facilities, and community events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Fresno City Council and Mayor Jerry P. Dyer, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2026 as:

“National Tennis Month”
