A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO.
2008-243 TO CONFORM RETENTION OF POLICE
RECORDS TO CALIFORNIA LAW

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2008, the Council passed Resolution No. 2008-243 setting forth a Citywide records retention schedule that adopted the Secretary of State Local Government Records Management Guidelines (City Retention Schedule); and

WHEREAS, the City Retention Schedule applies a five year minimum requirement to use of force, collision reviews, internal affairs reports, and reports of great bodily injury, but requires officer involved shooting (OIS) records to be maintained from the closure date plus twenty-five years; and

WHEREAS, State law (California Penal Code Section 832.5) requires OIS records be maintained from the closure date plus five years; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to amend the City Retention Schedule to conform to State law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. In compliance with State law, Resolution No. 2008-243 is hereby amended to require Officer Involved Shooting records to be maintained from the closure date plus five years.

2. Except as modified by this Resolution, Resolution No. 2008-243 remains in full force and effect.
